

CUMBERLAND COUNTY FARM BUREAU **AGRICULTURAL SCHOLARSHIP**

General Information

Cumberland County Farm Bureau recognizes the need for continued education and technical training in all areas of the agricultural industry. Funding towards Tuition is available through an established scholarship program for students and individual interested in furthering their education or skills in agriculture. High school seniors and individuals seriously interested in agricultural careers are eligible to apply for scholarships. Cumberland farmers interested in furthering their academic knowledge, skills, and gaining additional training may also apply for support funding through the Cumberland Farm Bureau Technical Assistance aspect of the funded Program. Support funding applications for 2024 for advancing agricultural endeavors will be available and accepted beginning January 1, 2024. Student applications must be received, or post marked by March 31, 2024. The applications will be reviewed by the Farm Bureau Scholarship Committee for award selections to be presented in May, 2024.

Applicants for scholarships or technical assistance support must be a Cumberland County resident, a high school senior, or further education student, a County farmer, or any County resident interested in advanced education in agriculture or related fields. Scholarships are available to established residents who have resided in Cumberland County for at least two years. Applicants must specify the amount of scholarship funds requested, and explain how Farm Bureau support would facilitate accomplishing career goals.

Agricultural Career Categories

Scholarship awards are funded for agricultural and related recognized career categories. Applications are accepted for students majoring in areas that include: Traditional Crop and Livestock Production (e.g. agronomy, animal nutrition, veterinary-technician, etc.); Agri-Business Management; Agricultural and Natural Resources; Agricultural Communications (i.e. RFD-TV); Building Construction; Agri-Science; Resource Development and Management; Agri-Tourism, Parks and Recreation; Products Packaging; Horticulture; Forestry; Food Science; Fisheries/Wildlife; Environmental Sciences.

Background

Virginia Farm Bureau scholarship funding towards tuition is available to farm families and individuals with the desire and interest in careers that promote the agricultural industry. Cumberland County Farm Bureau recognizes and supports the continued education and training of students, farmers, and residents interested in starting and/or continuing agricultural and related careers. County high school senior students, farmers, persons sincerely interested in furthering their academic knowledge, gaining additional training and improving their skills beyond high school graduation, or equivalent studies, may apply for support funding through the Cumberland County Farm Bureau Scholarship Program.

The Scholarship Program consists of two separate aspects for providing support funding to persons interested in pursuing further studies. The scholarship portion is managed through the Cumberland County High School and the Fuqua Upper School Guidance Offices. The Technical Assistance portion also is managed through the Cumberland County Farm Bureau Scholarship Committee. Final approval for each application resides with the County Farm Bureau Board.

CUMBERLAND COUNTY FARM BUREAU **SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION**

Carefully read through application before providing requested information.

Eligibility for Initial College/University Tuition Assistance:

1. Applicant must be either a Cumberland County High School senior, or County farmer/producer, or County resident interested in further education in agriculture.
2. Applicant must be an established resident of Cumberland County for two years.
3. Applicant must be accepted to an accredited College/University institution.
4. High School Seniors must provide three Letters of Recommendation from recent (within last three years) educators, pastors, County officials, employers, 4-H/FFA/ Scout Leaders. Letters may not be from family members.
5. High School Seniors should have a 2.5 grade-point-average/equivalent, or better, and provide updated education background and official transcript documentation.
6. Applicant may be interviewed by the Farm Bureau Scholarship Committee.

Second/Repeat scholarship applicant requirements:

1. Applicant must be either a Cumberland County farmer/producer, or established County resident for two years, interested in further education in agriculture.
2. Letter of interest with an update on educational progress, including verification of a 2.5 GPA such as official grade report or updated transcript.
3. Letter of justification for amount of funds requested.

Answers must be typed, double-spaced, one-sided on plain white paper.

- 1. Describe family background and past experiences with agriculture; and explain your present daily and/or seasonal involvement in agricultural, forestry, or environmental activities.**
- 2. State in essay form (250-300 words), your present plans toward an agricultural or environmental related career.**
- 3. List club or association memberships, including leadership roles in which you have participated: 4-H, FFA, etc. Also include participation in State Fairs, Science Fairs, etc. with agricultural or environmental emphasis.**

4. List and briefly discuss formal educational training you have completed regarding agricultural or environmental related areas (classroom courses, special workshops, internships, etc.).

5. Discuss (200-250 words) what you believe to be one or two of the more important issues that agriculture or the environment needs to address within the next five years.

6. List additional educational training you intend to pursue (majors, degrees, apprenticeships, summer jobs, etc.) while a college/university student.

7. Justify the amount of financial support requested and explain why you believe you should be selected as a Scholarship recipient.

8. Applicant may provide any additional information for the Farm Bureau Scholarship Committee to consider for this Application.
