YOU CAN HELP.

Donate your excess produce to food banks
and **receive a tax credit.**

HELP those in need.

One in ten Virginia families experience hunger. Many of them are households with children and seniors.

SUPPORT local food banks.

The Federation of Virginia Food Banks distributes more than 120 million pounds of food to almost 1 million Virginians each year. You can contribute to their efforts and help provide fresh, healthy food.

PUT the extra to good use.

Use a food bank as an outlet for excess or imperfect product.

BENEFIT from a tax credit.

The Commonwealth provides tax credits of up to 30% of market value for any crops donated, up to \$5,000 in credits per year.

When you donate, the food bank will give you a Virginia Food Crop Donation Certificate (**Form FCD-2**).

You submit an application (**Form FCD-1**).

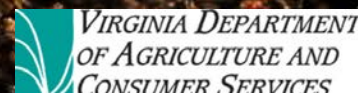
You'll receive a credit of 30% of the market value of your donation. If you exceed the \$5,000 credit limit, you can carry it over to the next five years until it's paid in full.
