We have removed environmental science from the list of qualifying majors.

The deadline for submission is Tuesday, April 8, 2025, with pick-up from Stafford County high school guidance offices being on or about Wednesday, April 9, 2025. A complete scholarship packet will consist of a completed scholarship form (with parent signature), an official high school transcript (including first semester grades and second semester courses), one written recommendation, an acceptance letter from the college you intend to attend, and one essay. The scholarship recipient will be announced at the high school senior awards night. The applications will be ranked using the following rubric (numbers in points):
